The Sterling Board of Trustees has built a 6' privacy fence on the southwest corner of the Village park. We have been asked if we would sell banners as advertising to place on this fence. The Trustees at the September 11 meeting have decided to do this with the following stipulations:

- A. All banners/signs must be 4' x 8'.
- B. Banners/signs may be made of any material except plywood.
- C. Banners/signs are to be made at the expense of the business owner with grommets included.
- D. The cost of putting a banner/sign will be \$150.00 per year payable at the time the sign is put on the fence.

The Village will put up the banner/sign upon receiving it at the Village office or by giving it to the Village superintendent (Spencer Pagel). We would like you to notify the Village office by **Friday, November 9** if you are interested in putting up a banner/sign. The banner/sign does not have to be made by then, but we would like to know if your business is putting one up. We will not be sending out this letter to other area community businesses until after November 9.

We would like to put up these banners/signs before the first baseball/softball game and take them down after the last home football game. The Village will take down the banners/signs and store them over the winter unless you wish to store them yourselves.

# Sterling Fire Department

TO: All owners of abandoned, unlicensed, and/or inoperable motor vehicles in Sterling, Nebraska

DATE: September 12, 2018

The Sterling Fire Department is undertaking a drive to assist with the removal of all abandoned, unlicensed, and/or inoperable motor vehicles from the Village of Sterling. By your participation in this effort, you will be contributing to the improvement of our community by removing all such vehicles from Sterling while also gaining a charitable tax deduction. The Sterling Fire Department will do the following to assist you in this drive:

1. The Sterling Fire Department will come to your vehicle's location and remove it.
2. The Sterling Fire Department will issue you a written receipt to be utilized as evidence of such donation for income tax purposes in an amount equivalent to the salvage value of such motor vehicle.
3. The Sterling Fire Department will dispose of such motor vehicle and receive any proceeds from the sale of disposition of such motor vehicle.

The only tasks you will be required to perform are to execute a title conveying such motor vehicle to the Sterling Fire Department if such title exists, or in the alternative, you can provide a Bill of Sale for such motor vehicle to the Sterling Fire Department as well as provide our members and/or representatives access to your premises to remove such motor vehicle.

If you are supportive of this drive and our efforts to improve Sterling and also have abandoned, unlicensed, and/or inoperable motor vehicles on your premises, please contact the Sterling Fire Department members, and they will be glad to assist you with the removal of any such motor vehicles from your premises.
