WATER METERS-SAMANTHA GORDON

We will soon be billing from water usage instead of household size. There's a letter included with your utility bill to explain this more in depth. If you would like to know what your usage has been since meters have been installed feel free to stop by the Village office.

AUTOMATIC PAYMENTS-SAMANTHA GORDON

With upgrading to the use of water meters our billing software has changed so will look different than you are used to. The customers that are currently signed up for ACH payments from FirstBank of Nebraska-Sterling will need to fill out a new Authorizations Agreement form for ACH debits if you'd like to continue with the ACH monthly payments. You can sign up for this at any time so are more than welcome to wait and see what the new rates will look like once we start billing off the meter usage. If you'd like to sign up for automatic payments please stop by the Village office.
