STERLING CODE

Sterling enforces the Nebraska code which is available in a searchable format on the website under Village Codes. Below are some of the codes that have come up recently for your information in a condensed version. Visit the website to view full codes.

91.19 WEEDS; LITTER; STAGNANT WATER

- (A) Lots or pieces of ground within the Village shall be drained or filled so to prevent stagnant water.
- (B) The owner of any lot or piece of ground in the Village shall keep the lot or piece of ground and the adjoining streets and alleys free of any growth of 12 inches or more in height of weeds, grasses, or worthless vegetation.
- (C) Littering is prohibited within the Village.
- (D) It is hereby declared a nuisance to permit or maintain any growth of 12 inches or more in height of weeds, grasses, or worthless vegetation.

93.02 ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE; TETHERING

- (A) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any animal, except a cat, to permit the animal to run at large at any time on any of the public ways and property or the property of another in the village, or to be tethered or staked out in such a manner so as to allow the animal to reach or pass into any public way or property or any property of another.
- (B) The owner of the cat may permit the cat to run at large within the corporate limits subject to any restrictions or prohibitions otherwise imposed by the Board of Trustees.
- (C) Any animal found running at large or tethered or staked out in violation of this section is a public nuisance and may be impounded or destroyed as provided in this chapter.
- (D) Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit anyone to own an animal in the corporate limits of the Village that is prohibited by the Board of Trustees.
