SANITATION AND RECYCLING

Do you have an old couch or dresser that you're wanting to get rid of?? Waste Connections can pick up bulky items from your curb for an additional fee that will be added to your monthly utility billing. To schedule a pickup or for a replacement garbage can please contact Waste Connections directly at 402-643-2054.

The village board reviewed the sanitation and recycling rates and voted to increase them by an additional \$1.50/month effective November 1, 2025, to account for inflation and the increased costs associated with such services.
