The Open Meetings Act and the location being the north wall of the fire hall. The public hearing was held in compliance with the provisions of the State Statute Sections 13-510 and 13-515 for the purpose of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to the budget the fiscal year 2012-2013..

Todd Blome, BMG, presented a budget review in regard to valuations and the tax levy. The tax levy increased from the past two years due to lower valuations. The tax rate for 2012-2013 is .0386827 for general fund purposes. No taxes were levied for bonded indebtedness as the bonds have been paid.

Wingert made a motion fo increase restricted fund levy by one percent and Weiss seconded the motion. Vote: yeas: all. Motion carried.
