With the recent installation of water meters, all Village of Sterling customers are now able to monitor their exact water usage. Please be aware that even minor issues, such as a leaking toilet, can result in significant increases in consumption and higher utility bills.

If the Village observes unusually high usage, staff will contact the customer to discuss potential causes. In cases where the increased usage is determined to be the result of an accidental issue that has been corrected, the Village Board will review the matter and may consider granting a partial adjustment to the bill.
