

SPECIAL MEETING
STERLING VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Sterling Village Board of Trustees held a special meeting on Tuesday, September 14, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Sterling Fire Hall. Chairman Heusman called the meeting to order and trustees answering roll call were: Scott Buss, Vane Rengstorf, Dwight Weiss, Chuck Wingert. Others present: LeRoy Riensche, Todd Blome, Steve Mercure, Steve Weiss, Steve Eickhoff, M.B. Keim, Audrey Keebler, Eldon Wilken. The Open Meetings Act was read and is located on the north wall of the Sterling Fire Barn.

Todd Blome, BMG, reviewed and discussed the budget with the Board of Trustees. The levy rate for 2010-11 is 0.555449. Total valuation has increased by approximately \$500,000.

Wingert made a motion to close the public hearing and Weiss seconded the motion. Vote: yeas: all. Motion carried.

Wingert made a motion to adopt the 2010-2011 budget and increase the restricted funds by 1%. Weiss seconded the motion. Vote: yeas: all. Motion carried.

Weiss made a motion to adopt Resolution 2010-5 providing that the property tax request for the 2010-2011 year for general purposes is set at \$62,277.27 and bond principal and interest is set for \$32,993.00. Heusman seconded the motion. Vote: yeas: all. Motion carried.
